What are cookies?

Cookies are small text strings that the websites visited by the user send to their device (usually to the browser), where they are stored and relayed once the user visits the website again. During the navigation of a website, the user can also receive cookies from other websites or Web servers (so-called "third-party") on which some elements on the visited website might be (such as images, maps, sounds, or specific links to web pages on other domains).

Cookies, usually found in users' browsers in very large number and sometimes very persistent, are used for different purposes: computer authentication processes, session monitoring, storing information about specific configurations on users who access the server, etc.

Cookies do not record any personal information about users and any identifiable data obtained will not be stored. If you want to disable the use of cookies, you must customise the settings on your computer, choosing to delete all cookies or to activate a warning message when cookies are stored. To proceed without changes to the cookies implementation, simply continue browsing.

What Are the Main Type of Cookies?

In this respect, and for the purposes of this Regulation, there are different types of cookies:

1. Technical Cookies

Those cookies are necessary to browse the website and fully use its features. By continuing to browse the website www.devodier.com you are agreeing that we may place cookies on your device.

2. Performance cookies

Performance cookies collect information about how you use a website (e.g., which pages are visited most and if the user receives any error messages from web pages). These cookies do not collect any information that could identify a user. All information collected through cookies is aggregated and therefore anonymous. They are only used to improving how a website works.

3. Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies allow the website to remember choices made by the user (such as name, language or region of origin) and to provide customised advanced features. These cookies can also be used to remember changes made to text size, fonts and other parts of Web pages that can be customised. They can also be used to provide services you have required, such as watching a video or commenting on a blog. The information collected from these cookies can be turned into anonymous information
